ORDER

As per the Government orders read as 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> papers above Government have recommended 92 Self Financing Institutions to the NCTE for recognition to start TTC course.

The Regional Director, NCTE, Bangalore as per the letter read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above has conveyed their approval for starting the course in 55 Self financing TTIs during 2004-2005 by admitting 50 students each in these institutions. The list of institutions is appended to this order.

On receipt of approval of NCTE to the above institutions, Government considered the norms to be fixed for admission of students for the TTC course in these institutions. After detailed examination of various aspects Government has fixed the following fees for the TTC Course both for the merit and management seats in Self-Financing TTIs.

Admission fees	- Rs.100/-
Tuition fees	- Rs.1000/- per month
Development fees	- Rs.3000/- per annum

Admission to merit seats in Self-Financing TTIs will be made in accordance with the existing norms in Government TTIs. In the case of management seats selection will be made by them on the basis of marks secured in the qualifying examination and interview.

Qualifying Examination 65%  
 Interview 35%

All the Self-financing TTIs will strictly follow the guidelines appended to this order as well as other NCTE norms in this regard.
